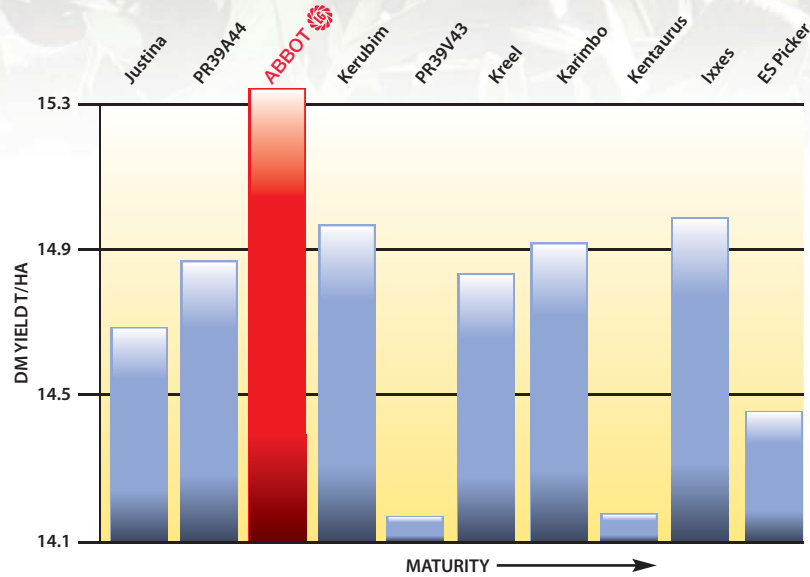

(Limagrain Trials 2003 - 2009)

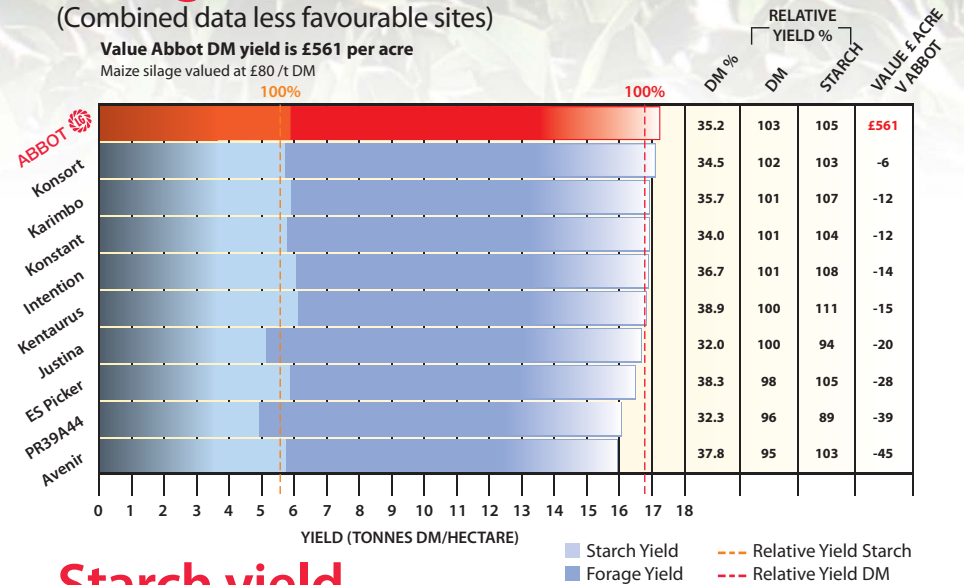


# Limagrain & NIAB trials 2005 - 2009

(Combined data less favourable sites)

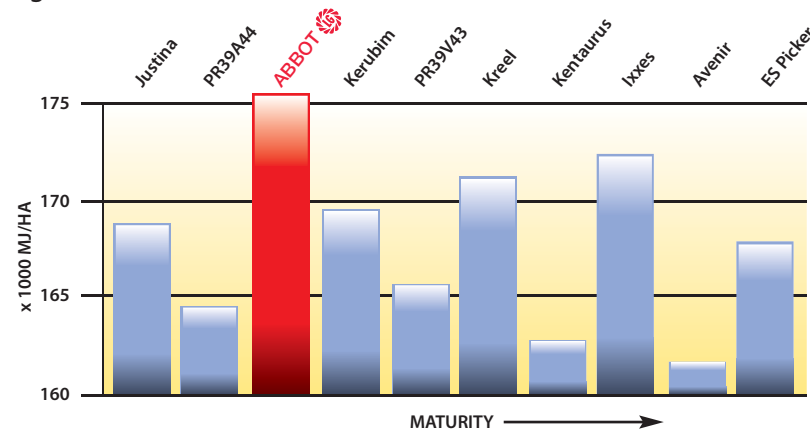
Value Abbot DM yield is £561 per acre

# ME Yields

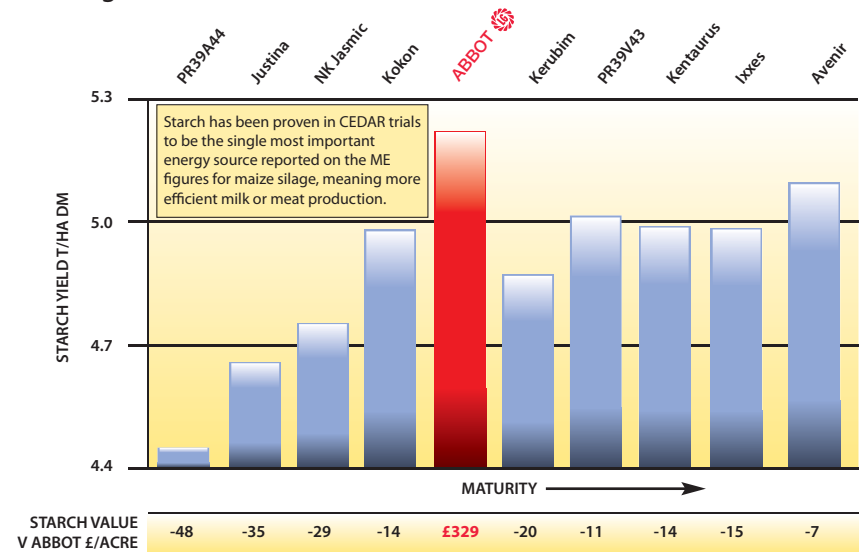
(Limagrain Trials 2003 - 2009)
