SUMMARY

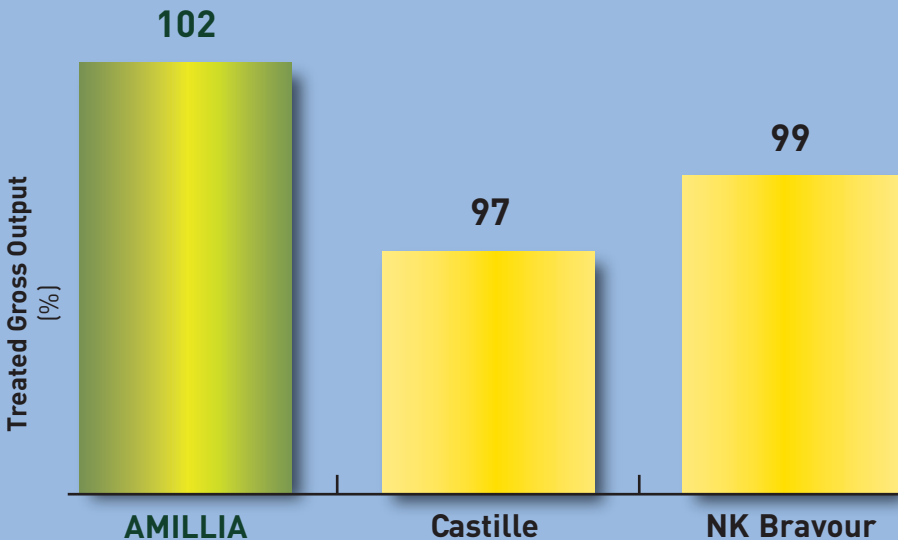
Amillia is a new conventional open-pollinated winter oilseed rape variety with a high gross output potential which has performed well in the HGCA East and West region. It has a solid package of agronomic characters and a very high oil content.

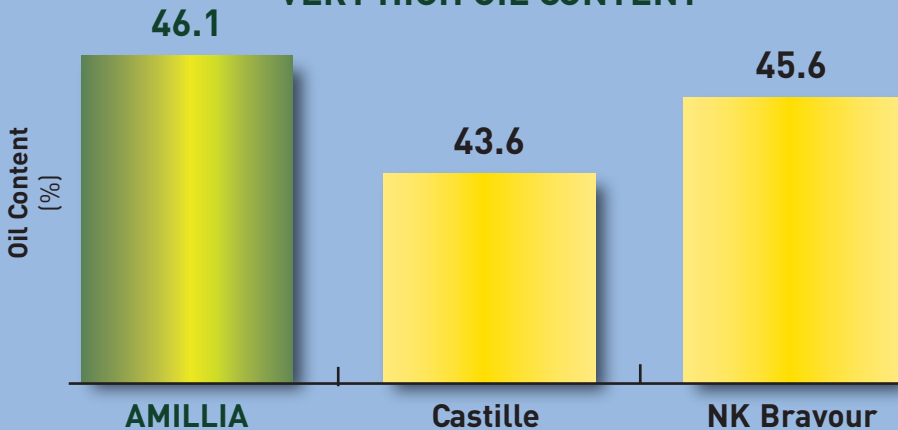
Amillia has a good all-round package of agronomic features. It is a medium height variety with good resistance to lodging and stiff stems, making it an easy variety to grow and harvest. Amillia is very early in its flowering and medium in maturity.

Amillia has good resistance to stem canker and similar light leaf spot resistance to Castille and NK Bravour.

VERY HIGH OIL CONTENT



Amillia has a very high oil content - nearly 3% above Castille - providing the grower with an increased chance of achieving valuable oil premiums.
