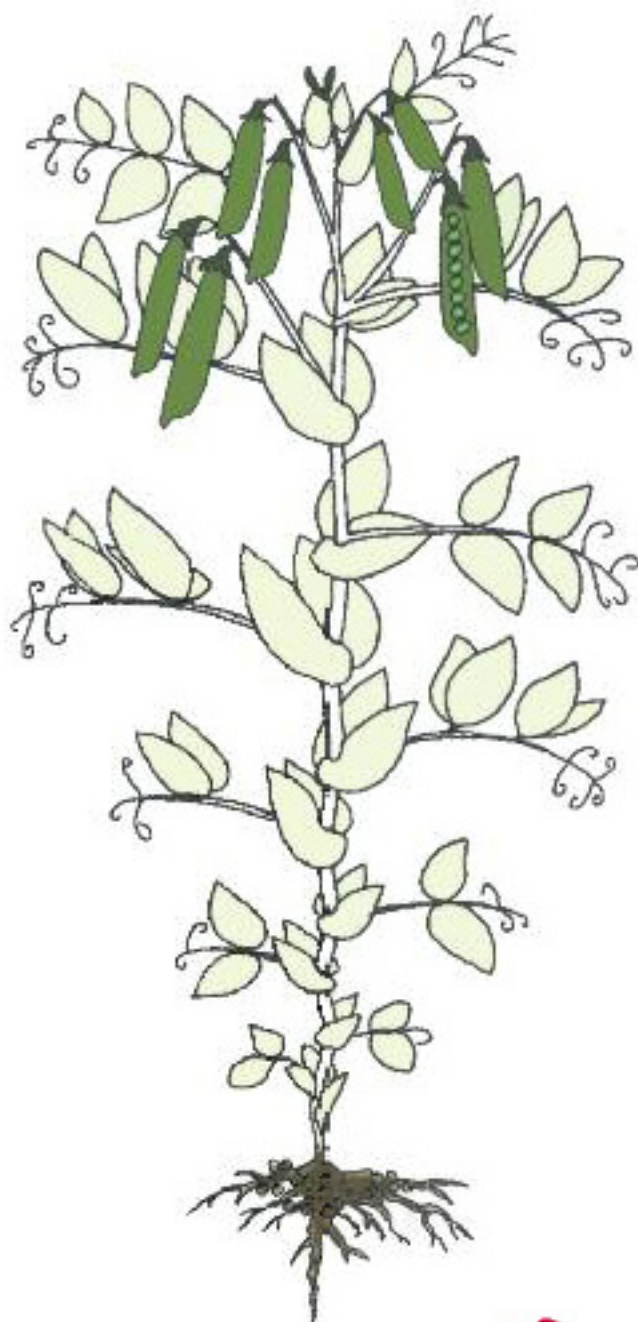

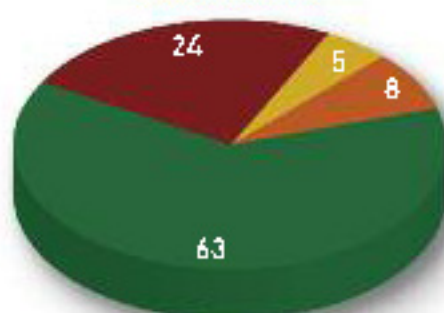

Sieve Size



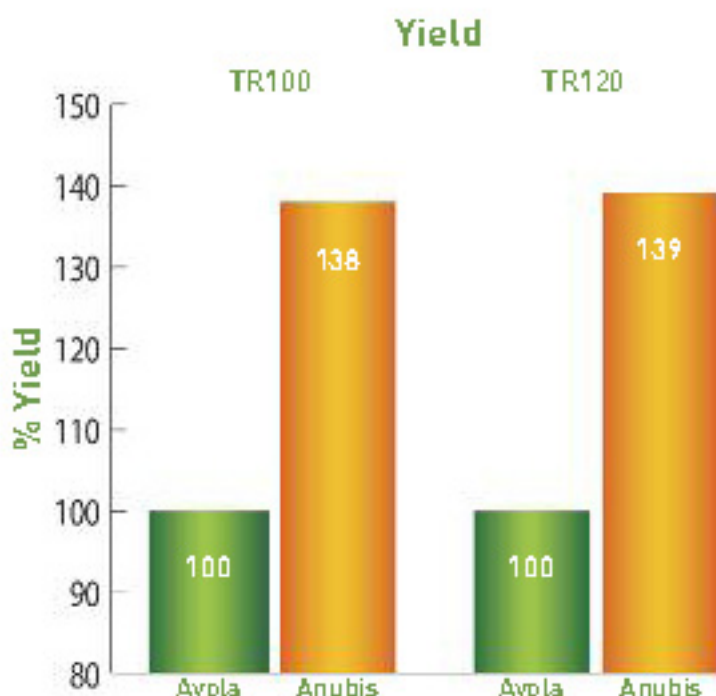
- Large >10.2mm
