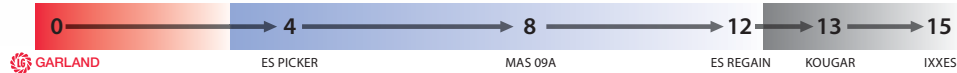

■ Out yields Kentaurus – worth an extra £20 per acre

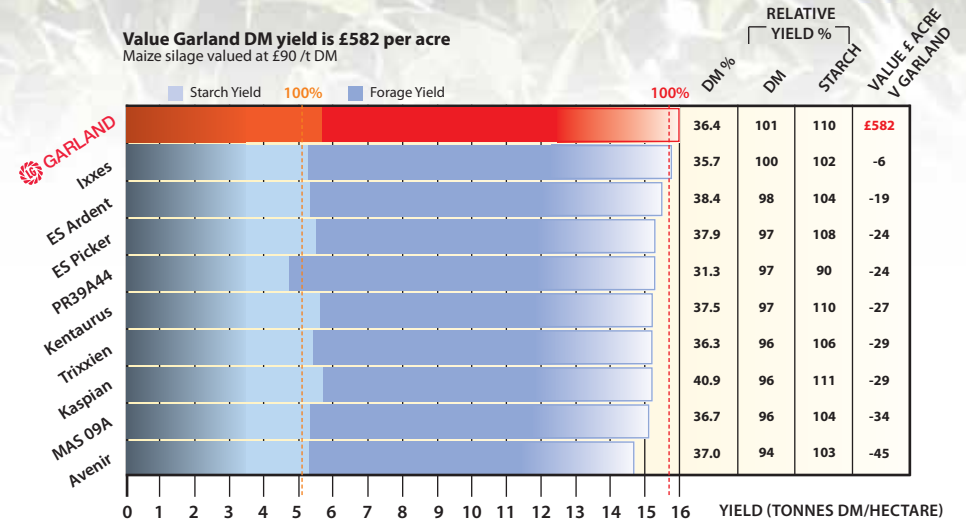

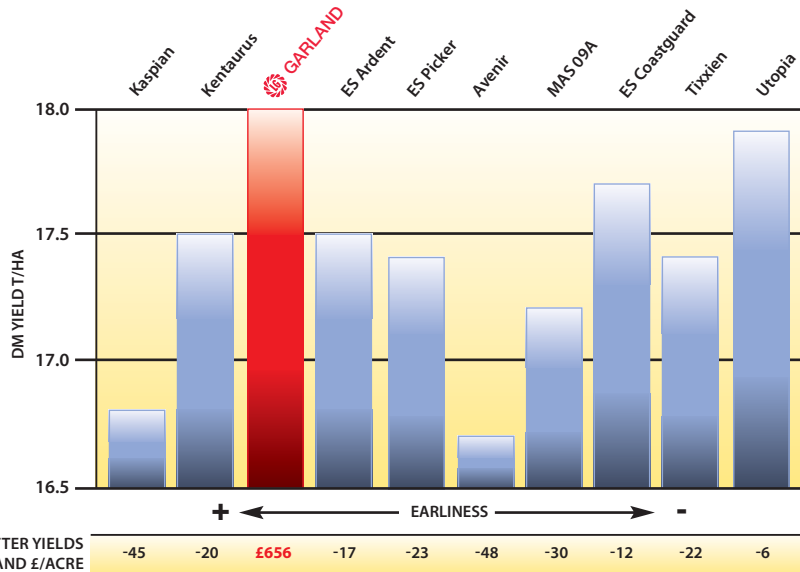

Dry matter yields

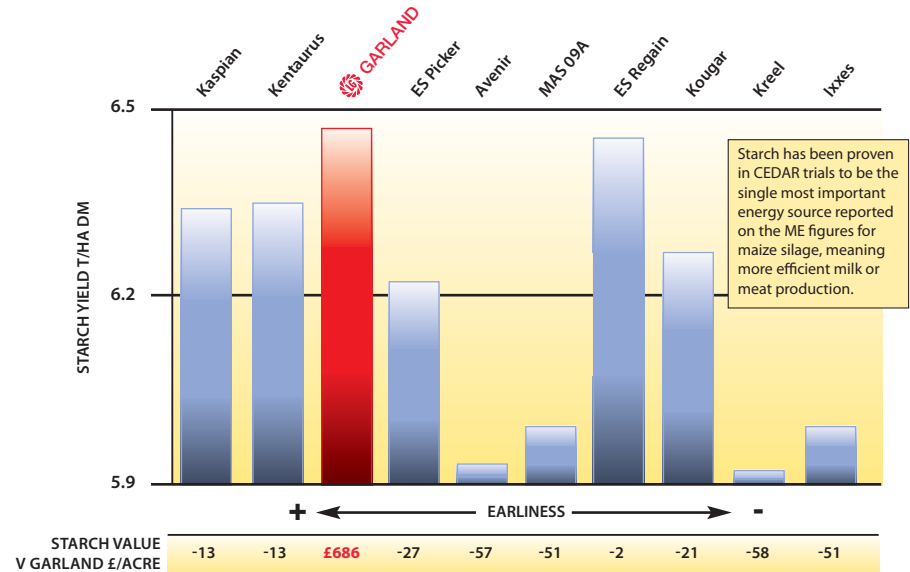
