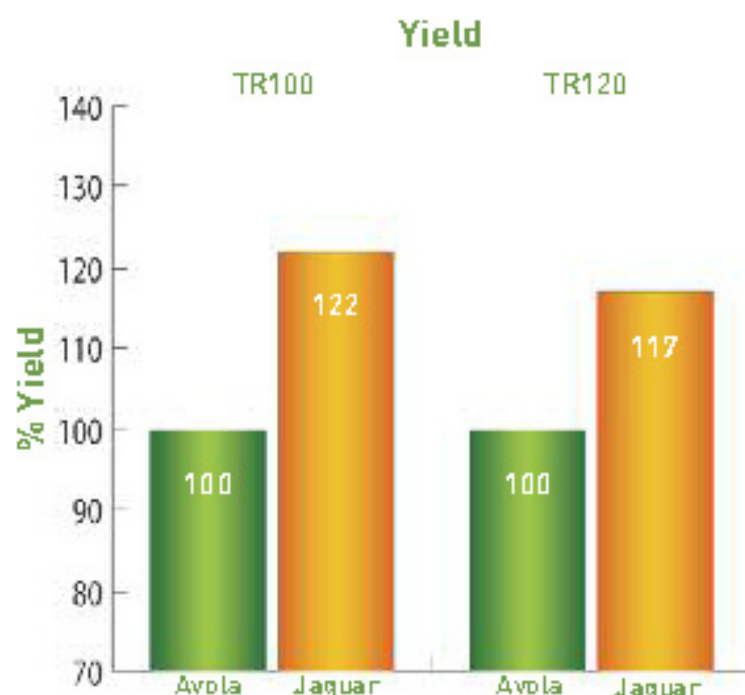


Mean Sieve Size
