SUMMARY

Tybalt is a very high yielding spring wheat with nabim Group 2 milling quality. It has excellent resistance to mildew, the rusts and *Septoria tritici* with moderately long straw. Tybalt is HGCA Recommended for both late autumn and spring sowing, offering growers great flexibility in drilling date.

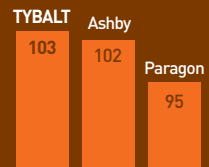

VERY HIGH YIELDING

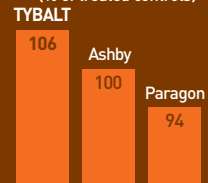
AUTUMN SOWN TREATED YIELD
