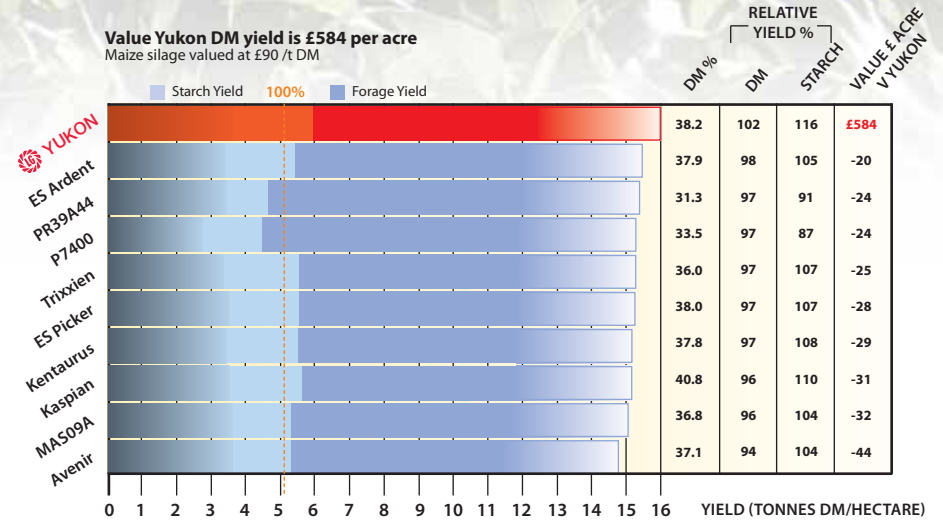

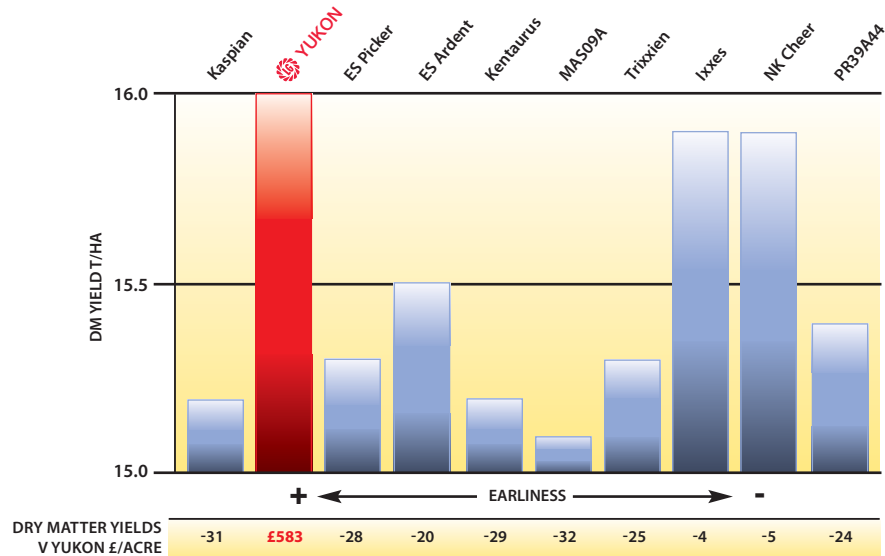

Dry matter yields

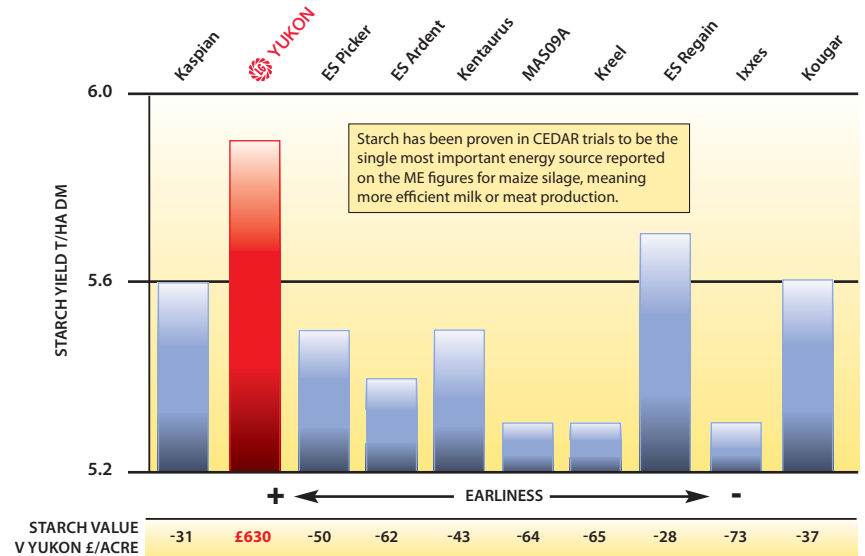
